Veterans service event provides one-stop-shop for veterans, spouses, transitioning military members

The Bexar County Veterans Service Office, in partnership with the Department of Veterans Affairs, Texas Veterans Commission, Texas Veterans Land Board, Texas Workforce Commission and other local agencies, is hosting the first ever VETSERV. This Veterans Service Event provides a one-stop-shop for applying for federal, state and local veterans benefits and resources. The event will be from 9 a.m. to 2 p.m. Saturday, Dec. 5, at Morgan's Wonderland, 5223 David Edwards Drive.

Open to all transitioning military, veterans, surviving spouses and dependents, this free event will allow attendees to check status of claims, file for disability compensation or pension, enroll in VA healthcare, apply for a VA home loan or housing assistance, order military records, obtain a resume and LinkedIn profile review, and even get photos taken for employment related social media sites. Attendees wanting assistance with their LinkedIn profile should dress professionally. Texas Rio Grande Legal Assistance will also have lawyers on hand to provide legal assistance through the Ask-a-Lawyer project.
