## **District Clerk to join Passport Day in the USA outreach event**

The Office of Donna Kay McKinney, Bexar County District Clerk, is hosting a special passport event from 10 a.m. to 3 p.m. Saturday, March 9, to provide passport information to U. S. citizens and to accept passport applications. Even though the Department of State has cancelled opening their federal offices for *Passport Day in the USA 2013* due to sequestration, the District Clerk's Office is still opening for this national passport acceptance and outreach event.

U. S. citizens must present a valid passport book when entering or re-entering the United States by air. U. S. citizens entering the United States from Canada, Mexico, the Caribbean and Bermuda at land borders and sea ports of entry must present a passport book, passport card, or other travel documents approved by the U. S. government.
