SUBJECT: 5 Arrested in Home Invasion

On January 19, 2009 at 2:50 a.m., the Bexar County Sheriff's responded to the 6800 Blk of Neston for a Home Invasion. Upon making the location the 26 year old victim stated that she heard a knock on her front door and found a female wearing a black "Hoody" asking for help. The victim opened the door to help the girl when 4 males hiding along the front door wall forced their way into her residence pointing handguns in her face and wearing ski mask and black hoodies over their face. The victim stated that the girl and another male stayed in the front room pointing guns at her and her 5 children while the other 3 males went into various rooms stealing various items. The victim stated all 5 fled out the back door turning left into the back alley.

Deputies immediately responded checking the alley behind the victims residence. Through diligence and perseverance, Sheriff's Deputies located a male subject fitting the victim's description. Harold Crenshaw DOB: 11-22-58 of the 8300 BLK of Tuxford was taken into custody. Upon further investigation and questioning, deputies were led to the 6800 BLK of Neston where the other actors were believed to be. Upon checking the residence Deputies located the other 4 actors, Kyron Sanders DOB: 06-03-91 of the 100 BLK of Bookers Palm, Jesse Owens DOB: 11-01-86 of the 2400 BLK of Christian, Trevion Chase DOB: 04-20-91 of the 6800 BLK of Neston, and Jermaine Barton DOB: 05-07-91 of the 7000 BLK of Glen Park, involved in the Home Invasion. Sheriff's Deputies and Criminal Investigators also recovered the stolen items taken from the Home Invasion along with weapons and ski mask, still in their possession, used in the criminal offense.

All male subjects were arrested for Aggravated Robbery and each have a \$75,000.00 bond.
