Message for Bexar County employees regarding swine flu

Because of the two confirmed cases of swine influenza in the Schertz-Cibolo area, Bexar County Judge Nelson Wolff, acting upon a recommendation from Dr. Bryan Alsip, is requesting that any Bexar County employees who live in Guadalupe County and who feel ill with flu-like symptoms stay home. Those symptoms include fever, lethargy, lack of appetite, sore throat, nausea, vomiting and diarrhea. Dr. Alsip is acting medical director for the City of San Antonio.

County employees who have family members who attend SCUC ISD or feel ill with flu-like symptoms also should consider staying home to avoid spreading infection. Those employees who are not ill and do report to work should protect themselves and others through practicing good hygiene, including washing hands often with soap and water or cleaning hands with alcohol-based sanitizing hand gels, and by covering coughs and sneezes using tissues.

Anyone who feels flu-like symptoms should contact their physician and avoid large gatherings and public places.
