Commissioner Sergio “Chico” Rodriguez resigns from BexarMet Water District Legislative Oversight Committee

Bexar County Commissioner Sergio “Chico” Rodriguez submitted his letter of resignation to the Chair and Co-Chair of the BexarMet Legislative Oversight Committee yesterday afternoon. The Committee was established during the 80th Legislative Session in an attempt to establish oversight to the troubled water district.

The State Legislature entrusted the oversight committee led by Chair, Senator Uresti and Co-Chair Representative Corte, to monitor the progress in the efficiency of BexarMet’s duty to provide quality water and service to its customers. During the oversight period given to the committee, there have been public meetings which all allowed time for public testimony. During the most recent meeting last month, Commissioner Chico Rodriguez verbally expressed opposition to the drafted report and recommendation developed by the Chair and Co-chair. Requests for changes to the drafted report were submitted and after receiving no response Commissioner Chico Rodriguez submitted a letter of resignation to Senator Uresti and Representative Corte.
