Life Sentence received for 1993 Capital Murder.

March 8, 2001.

San Antonio, Texas: Today, in the 379th Judicial District Court, a 25 year old San Antonio man was sentenced to life in prison after pleading guilty to capital murder in the death of a local record store owner.

The Defendant, Raul Calvillo, Jr., was charged with the capital murder of 48 year old Rudolph "Rudy" Gonzales, Jr., on February 2, 1993. Mr. Gonzales was beaten and strangled to death in his store, *Rio Records*, located in the 1400 block of South Alamo Street. Mr. Gonzales' wallet, stereo and other items were missing when a co-worker discovered the crime on February 3, 1993.

There were no suspects in the case until 1998, when the San Antonio Police Department developed Calvillo as a suspect.
