



# *Advanced Automotive Manufacturing*

Bexar County is the site of the Toyota Tundra truck manufacturing plant, the most advanced automobile manufacturing plant in the world. The 2000-acre plant includes 21 on-site suppliers and room for future expansion. The presence of the world's leading automotive manufacturer here reflects the valuable assets and conditions Bexar County provides to the automotive industry.
