The parade helps motivate students from 3rd to 5th grade and rewards them for their hard work in preparation for the Texas Assessment of Knowledge and Skills (TAKS) test scheduled to begin Tuesday, March 3rd.

The students were reminded to get plenty of sleep, eat a good breakfast and take their time while completing their test. Commissioner Chico Rodriguez led the rally with the chant “si se puede” encouraging students to do their best and handed out “high-fives” during the parade around the school campus.
