**Commissioner Chico Rodriguez
leads effort to establish Precinct 1 satellite office**

South Side residents will soon be able to handle county business with more ease as Bexar County's first satellite office facility is set to open this fall. The building was formerly a Winn's Department Store and is located at 3505 Pleasanton Road, south of Military Drive. It is easily accessed from the southern part of Loop 410 via the exit for Pleasanton/Moursund Road. It is also served by VIA Metropolitan Transit with bus stops adjacent to the location in both the north and south direction.

"Accessibility for my constituents has always been a priority for me," said Commissioner Sergio "Chico" Rodriguez. "One of my first goals when I took office was to create a satellite office in Precinct 1 to allow my constituents better access and convenience to county services."

The 32,000 square foot building will house offices for the Tax Assessor-Collector, Justice of the Peace, Constable, and Precinct 1 County Commissioner Sergio "Chico" Rodriguez. Some of the services offered to residents will be vehicle registrations, acceptance of property tax payment, civil marriage ceremonies, payment of court fines, law enforcement services and constituent services for Precinct 1.

"Three of the biggest reasons I hear as to why my constituents dislike coming to the courthouse Downtown is the lack of parking, the distance and traffic," Commissioner Chico Rodriguez said. "This facility will accommodate everyone with ample free parking, close proximity to a major highway and less traffic congestion."

After Commissioner Chico Rodriguez identified the need for a satellite office in his precinct, he pushed the idea and drew 100% support from his colleagues on Commissioners Court. The existing building was chosen due to its cost efficiency and ideal location. As Bexar County's South Side continues to develop and grow, a large number of residents are expected to use the services that will be provided at the new Precinct 1 satellite office facility.
