City of Somerset & Surrounding Area Beautification Campaign**

With the help of Commissioner Chico Rodriguez, the Bexar County Sheriff’s Department and many volunteers, the City of Somerset kicked off this month-long campaign on Saturday as a collective effort to beautify the City and surrounding area by painting over graffiti and cleaning streets heavily littered with trash and debris.

Bexar County Commissioner Chico Rodriguez and City of Somerset Mayor Paul Cuellar thanked all of the volunteers and encouraged them to continue in their efforts to keep the community beautiful.
