Rodricus Harvey is the Small, Minority, Women-Owned Business Enterprise (SMWBE) Contract Compliance Specialist for Bexar County. His duties are to maintain and review plans, schedules, budgets, progress reports, and customer feedback to ensure contract performance. He also assists in the process of developing and evaluating requests for proposals for services to support program goals. Rodricus serves as a liaison with Bexar County departments, external agencies and contractors to assist in development and implementation of policies and programs designed to promote economic development within the county.
