Don't be tricked by bogus tax notices

Bexar County Tax Assessor-Collector Sylvia S. Romo is warning taxpayers not to be fooled by bogus tax collection notices that are appearing on the doors of residential properties in the County.

Various notices have been posted on homes, including residential rental properties. These false notices give the impression that the property owner has outstanding delinquent taxes and threatens that all occupants of the property will be subject to arrest and their property seized.

“Don't be misled! Delinquent property tax collection notices from the Tax Assessor-Collector's Office are on official letterhead and arrive only in the mail,” Romo said. “Notices of a lawsuit filed by a collection attorney also will arrive by mail or be served by a peace officer.”
