BiblioTech partners with Alamo Colleges to offer tech certification classes

Commissioners Court approved an agreement Tuesday with Alamo Colleges to offer Support Help Desk (Network+) I-BEST courses at the BiblioTech Pleasanton Road branch. The coursework will help students develop the skills and knowledge base they need to apply to the Open Cloud Academy and/or seek employment opportunities. Under the partnership, Alamo Colleges will provide the skills training free of charge to students who meet certain criteria.

College coursework and integrated basic skills training will begin June 13, classes will meet four days per week for 12 weeks. Students will work with career navigators and additional learning support will be provided.

Students must be 18 years or older, able to work legally in the United States, registered with Selective Service (if male), and be below an 8th grade level in reading, writing or math. Initial testing for course eligibility will be conducted May 26 and June 2 at BiblioTech, 3505 Pleasanton Road.
