Call for applications to serve on Technical Advisory Committee

Bexar County Commissioners Court is now accepting applications for a volunteer position on the Technical Advisory Committee for Persons with Disabilities. The 5-member committee serves in an advisory capacity to Commissioners Court and county staff regarding compliance with the Americans with Disabilities Act, Rehabilitation Act of 1973 and the Elimination of Architectural Barriers under Texas Government Code.

To qualify for appointment, a person has to be a Bexar County resident, be disabled or have knowledge/experience in working with persons with disabilities, and be interested in the betterment of Bexar County and its relationship with disabled citizens. Members serve two-year terms and may be reappointed. Meetings are held once a month or as deemed necessary by the committee.

The committee makes recommendations to Commissioners Court on issues concerning employment policies and practices, provision of services and programs, and access to facilities. The committee also educates county employees to inform and sensitize them to various accessibility problems faced by disabled persons.
