Update - County Clerk Offers Free Valentine's Day Weddings

County Clerk Lucy Adame-Clark will conduct free mass wedding ceremonies on the steps of the Bexar County Courthouse on Valentine's Day. To comply with social distancing guidelines, each ceremony will be limited to 22 couples and registration is required. Please visit https://www.bexar.org/2957/Marriage-Licenses to register. All ceremonies will take place on the north side of the Courthouse at 100 Dolorosa, San Antonio, Texas 78205. Due to the high demand for appointments, the County Clerk's Office added another ceremony at 11 a.m. The ceremonies will be held on Monday, February 14, 2022 at the following times:

- ♥ 12:01 a.m.
- ♥ 10 a.m. (FULL)
- ♥ 11 a.m.
- ♥ Noon (FULL)
- ♥ 2 p.m.
- ♥ 4 p.m. (FULL)

The Bexar County Clerk will be joined by the Postmaster of San Antonio, Mr. Robert D. Carr Jr., for the unveiling of the 2022 USPS LOVE STAMP at noon. Amazing Grace Doves will join the 2 p.m. ceremony for a memorable dove release presentation. Marriage ceremonies officiated by Mrs. Adame-Clark are free, but we do ask for a \$20 donation which goes to the Battered Women and Children's Shelter and the Bexar County Family Justice Center.

Couples should obtain a marriage license 72 hours prior to their scheduled ceremony, unless:

- An applicant is a member of the U.S. armed forces and is on active duty; or
- ♥ The applicants complete a premarital education course approved by the state of Texas and provides the course completion certificate to the County Clerk; or
- ♥ A judge waives the waiting period for good cause.

Marriage licenses can be obtained from the Bexar County Clerk's Office on the first floor of the Paul Elizondo Tower at 101 W. Nueva St., Suite 120 or at one of the "Records on the Run" mobile unit locations. The fee for a marriage license is \$81 and both applicants must provide proof of identity and age as well as their Social Security number (if any).
