*****Update*** Fire Marshal Investigates Death on Far Westside**

On Wednesday, February 9, 2022, at approximately 6:50 a.m., Bexar County Fire Dispatch received a 9-1-1 call about a house fire in the 9800 block of Misty Plain Drive in San Antonio.

Firefighters arrived on scene at 6:59 a.m. and noticed heavy smoke coming from the house. Personnel from Emergency Services District (ESD) 2 handled the initial response. They received assistance from ESD 5 and Joint Base San Antonio Lackland Fire Department. Overall, some 33 personnel were involved in the effort.

During the initial, preliminary search of the house, once the fire had been extinguished, nobody was found. However, during a more thorough follow-up search, a dead person was located inside.

Update:

The deceased was identified as Jimmy Anthony Dehoyos (47). Mr. Dehoyos was the owner of the house that caught on fire. The cause of that fire remains undetermined at this time.

The investigation is ongoing.
