Bexar County Auditor Receives Certificate of Excellence

On February 4, 2022, Bexar County was notified by the Chicago-based Government Finance Officers Association of the United States and Canada that it was awarded the Certificate of Achievement for Excellence in Financial Reporting. The certificate recognizes the Bexar County Auditor's Office for its annual comprehensive financial report for the fiscal year ended September 30, 2020.

The report has been judged by an impartial panel to meet the high standards of the program, which includes demonstrating a constructive "spirit of full disclosure" to clearly communicate its financial story and motivate potential users and user groups to read the report.

Bexar County Auditor Leo Caldera reacted by saying, "We have received the certificate in previous years, and I am very happy to once again see the work of our employees recognized in this fashion. Financial information and its presentation is not typically considered exciting literature, yet it is essential to provide an accurate accounting of Bexar County's financial position. We take great pride in the quality of our report."
