Bexar County Heat Preparedness

Bexar County residents will once again experience a period of extremely hot weather today and tomorrow. Residents are asked to conserve power during the hours of 2:00 p.m. and 8:00 p.m. With current temperatures and the heat index hovering at dangerous levels, the county has made its own preparations in addition to resources available from the City of San Antonio.

Seven Bexar County cooling centers are open today and tomorrow. As during previous incidents, operation of these cooling locations is made possible through cooperation with our Emergency Services Districts (ESD). The City of San Antonio also maintains their locations, which can be found [here](#).

Opening hours for the cooling centers will be from 1:00 p.m. to 10:00 p.m. Emergency personnel will be at each location to assist residents who seek shelter from the heat. Bottled water will be available. In addition, water and ice at a larger scale are either in storage or available from local vendors who have been notified.

Bexar County, working directly with Meals on Wheels, will be checking in with residents in unincorporated Bexar County and suburban cities.
