Bexar County Arrests More Illegal Dumpers

The Bexar County Environmental Services Department with its environmental crimes investigators continues to pursue illegal dumpers. While the Camelot neighborhood remains a focus of investigative activity, other areas of unincorporated Bexar County also receive added attention by our specialized investigators.

Investigators received information and photos showing two suspects in the process of illegally disposing of mattresses and box springs. Further investigation resulted in probable cause to issue arrest warrants for

- Rhonda Dutton (61)
- Larry Donell Williams (64)

With assistance from the Bexar County Fire Marshal's Office and the Bexar County Sheriff's Office, environmental crimes investigators safely took suspect Dutton into custody on Monday, August 22, 2022 and suspect Williams on Thursday, September 1, 2022. They were booked into the Bexar County Adult Detention Center on charges of Illegal Dumping (Texas Health and Safety Code [HSC] Section 365.012), a Class B Misdemeanor (greater than 5 pounds, less than 500 pounds). Williams has also been charged with violation of HSC Section 365.012 Illegal Dumping (greater than 200 pounds for commercial purposes), a state jail felony.
