Bexar County Offices to reopen tomorrow, Thursday, February 2, 2023

The Bexar County Office of Emergency Management continues to monitor the weather. Although the ground is saturated, temperatures are expected to increase above freezing. In consideration of the most current weather forecast, Bexar County will resume normal hours of operations tomorrow, February 2, 2023.

County Judge Peter Sakai stated, "I appreciate the care and consideration Bexar County residents have shown over the past two days and encourage everyone to exercise extreme caution throughout the rest of this weather event. While county offices will be open, the possibility of dangerous conditions may persist, especially in the far northern portion of the county. Please be diligent as you navigate across the area."
