### **County Offices to close on Friday, February 24 at 12 PM for Active Shooter Training**

#### **Traffic Advisory\*\*\*Noise Advisory\*\*\***

Tomorrow, Friday, February 24, 2023, at 12 p.m., all County offices located in the County Downtown Complex (Bexar County Courthouse, Paul Elizondo Tower, the Justice Center, the Annex building, the Information Technology Office and the Human Resources office) will close to the public for Active Shooter Training and Mock Event (AST) by Order of the County Commissioners Court. No deliveries to these facilities will be accepted after 12 p.m.

Bexar County Commissioners Court with the Bexar County Sheriff's Office, the Office of Emergency Management, and the Bexar County District Courts will host an Active Shooter Training for employees.

Protective orders and other essential services provided by the District Clerk's Office will continue at the Family Justice Center, 126 E. Nueva, 2<sup>nd</sup> floor.

Marriage licenses and other services provided by the County Clerk's Office will be available via their Records on the Run mobile unit that will be located at 232 Iowa Street, the County's Records Center.

During this exercise, the public can expect to see an increase in the number of emergency vehicles and at times, may experience excessive noise levels. There is no need for citizens to be alarmed.

The exercise will end no later than 5 p.m.

County offices will reopen for business on Monday, February 27, 2023, at normal business hours.
