The Domestic Relations Office (DRO) provides social and mental health services support, supervised visitation and neutral exchanges, cooperative parenting group classes and a visitation enforcement program to the Civil District Courts

### **Consultation and Referral by DRO Director, Tony Neugebauer:**

- Available to Judges entire day in DRO.
- Assessments of child expressed objectives and issue-specific child interviews, mediation-type collaboration with attorneys, parties, children, collaterals to narrow the issues in access/visitation issues. DRO contains Order of Referral to DRO that should be signed by attorneys and judge for this service.
- Triage for appropriate mental health services such as: child custody evaluations, psychological evaluations, parent coordination, counseling and cooperative parenting classes.
- Assist judges and attorneys to “match” evaluator to case.

### **Child Custody Evaluators List:**

- List available from DRO.
- Evaluators who meet state and local criteria.
- Limited pro bono evaluations if ordered by judge.
- Low Cost Child Custody Evaluation program available to qualified parties

### **Cooperative Parenting Program Services:**

### **Bexar County Shared Parenting Program (formerly ACCESS Visitation Enforcement):**

- Aids only non-custodial parents with enforcement of visitation.
- Program requirements:
  - Valid final Bexar County court order with specific visitation terms.
  - Non-custodial parent, custodial parent and children reside in Bexar County.
  - Non-custodial parent unable to afford attorney.
- Orientations conducted weekly by the DRO. Contact office to sign up @ 335-1242.
- To provide visitation education to help educate parents about court orders.
