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NOTICE OF POSTPONEMENT OF PUBLIC HEARING BY BEXAR COUNTY COMMISSIONER COURT

Proposed Changes to Bexar County Lighting Order

The public hearing regarding proposed changes to the County Order for outdoor lighting requirements scheduled to be held Tuesday, October 17, 2017 in the Double-Height Courtroom on the Second Floor of the Bexar County Courthouse, 100 Dolorosa, Suite 2.01, San Antonio, Texas 78205 has been postponed. Bexar County is coordinating with the City of San Antonio, JBSA, and the community to ensure changes to the existing Military Lighting Order and Ordinance are aligned with one another.

The findings of the City of San Antonio's Dark Skies Initiative were presented on September 15, 2017 recommending updates to the Military Lighting Overlay District Ordinance (please view the following link for more information: <http://www.sanantonio.gov/sustainability/DarkSkyPolicyEvaluation>). In conjunction, the City of San Antonio is meeting with the development community, JBSA, TxDOT, School Districts, and Bexar County to update their current Military Lighting Overlay District Ordinance. The working draft incorporates a majority of the amendments recommended in the 2015 Ambient Lighting Study.

The updates to the City and County Lighting Order/Ordinance are expected to be presented to City County and Commissioners Court in the first quarter of 2018.
