

# Community meeting to outline Bulverde Road flood project

A community meeting Tuesday will provide details of a lengthy Bexar County flood control project planned for low-water crossings at Bulverde Road at Jung Road on the city's far North Side.

The 7 p.m. meeting will be in [Redland Oaks Elementary School](#).

The \$4.2 million project, with construction slated to start in December 2013, would continue to February 2015.

The project would improve the low-water crossing on Bulverde Road at a tributary of Mud Creek. Also, Jung Road will be realigned to eliminate the low-water crossing east of Bulverde Road.

County flood control officials and contractors will be on hand to explain the project.

Another public meeting is slated for March 27 regarding plans to eliminate a low-water crossing on Jones-Maltsberger Road at Elm Creek. That meeting will be at 7 p.m. at [Driscoll Middle School](#), 17150 Jones Maltsberger. The project near Loop 1604 has the same timetable as the Bulverde Road project.
