Bexar County's 2018 One Year Action Plan

PROPOSED STATEMENT OF PROJECTED USE OF FUNDS FOR PROGRAM YEAR 2018 COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT, HOME AND ESG PROGRAMS

On June 19, 2018, Bexar County Commissioners Court approved the Proposed Statement of Use of Funds for the Program Year 2018 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), the HOME Investment Partnerships Program and Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG) funds. On October 1, 2018, Bexar County expects to receive from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development \$2,389,710 in CDBG funds, \$737,702 in HOME funds and \$196,678 in ESG funds. The proposed allocations are as follows:

Program Year 2018 CDBG, HOME and ESG project allocations have been developed giving maximum feasible priority to activities that benefit low and moderate income families in accordance with the County's Community Development objectives and priorities as set forth in the 2016 – 2020 Consolidated Plan. Members of Commissioners Court will review all written comments received during the required thirty day comment period prior to final approval of Annual Action Plan which shall be received at the address specified above. A final determination on the Annual Action Plan for Program Year 2018 funds for each entitlement program will be made in Commissioners Court on July 24, 2018. The Annual Action Plan will be submitted to the Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) by August 15, 2018 as part of the County's 2016 – 2020 Five Year Consolidated Plan.
