To Whom It May Concern:

Bexar County Public Works is providing an addendum and responding to the written questions received on its Request for Statements of Qualifications for Talley Road Phase II (MPO) – Wiseman Blvd to Tamaron Pass. Consultant SOQs must be submitted by interested candidates no later than **4:00 pm on Friday, October 12, 2018.**

Note that substantive deficiencies in vital areas could result in non-selection of a firm.

1) Responses to Written Questions

If the prime firm is a minority, can the prime firm be classified within the targeted Small, Minority, and Women-Owned Business Enterprises minimum goal of 20%? Or is the prime firm excluded from that minimum goal, and the 20% must be made up of the prime's sub-consultants?

The prime firm can count toward the targeted goal. That being said, it is always appreciated if other local small businesses and local firms are also represented on the team. This is not a scored criteria, but is looked at and considered should firms be shortlisted

Hopefully, these responses to the questions submitted by the consultants will assist you in the preparation of your Statement of Qualifications.
