BOND CONDITIONS FOR MISDEMEANOR FAMILY VIOLENCE CASES


This STANDING ORDER of Judge Rosie Speedlin Gonzalez, Presiding Judge of County Court at Law No. 13, hearing misdemeanor family violence cases, is intended to direct the Bexar County Pre-Trial Services Office and Bexar County Magistrate Judges conducting magistration duties at the Justice Intake Assessment Annex (JIAA), pursuant to Texas Code of Criminal Procedure §17.15 and *O'Donnell v. Goodhart*, 900 F.3d 200 (5th Cir. 2018), as follows:

ALL BOND CONDITIONS—including, but not limited to, GPS and NO CONTACT ORDERS—shall remain in effect for every bond posted by a Defendant in a particular case until the final disposition of the case unless:

- a. Otherwise directed by the Court (such as waivers); or
- b. Defense Counsel and the District Attorney's Office via their designated Assistant D.A. agree to amended conditions of release on bond via an "AGREED SPECIAL CONDITIONS ON BOND" order; or
- c. Defense Counsel files a Motion Requesting a 2nd Individualized Bond Hearing for their client seeking specific remedies that the Court should consider in assessing modified conditions of release on bond (this motion should be properly filed, served on the D.A.'s Office and set for a hearing via the Court's Coordinator).

It is ORDERED that this STANDING ORDER be filed and recorded with the County Clerk of Bexar County
