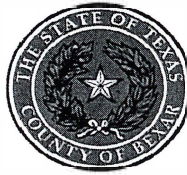

SPECIAL ORDER ON COVID-19 PROTOCOL FOR COUNTY COURTS

The County Court judges have unanimously agreed to the following plan for the next 30 days due to recent updates on the COVID-19 virus. This is a fluid situation subject to re-assessment and/or change within this time-frame of 30 days.

- 1) The County Court Judges are rescheduling all Criminal and Civil dockets for 30 days from today, March 16, 2020, until April 16, 2020, although judges will be available daily;
- 2) The County Court Judges do not have any objection to Magistrates setting bonds on inmates with Motion to Revoke Probation (MTR) cases or cases with a Remand Without Bond status; and
- 3) Any matters involving inmates will be sent to Auxiliary Jail court located at 200 N. Comal. Inmates will not be brought to the courthouse. All attorneys must set up remote visitation with jailed inmates, or arrange for in-person visitation at the jail;
