**ORDER CONTINUING ORDER REGARDING SETTINGS IN
PRESIDING CIVIL DISTRICT COURT AND
JURY MONITORING COURT**

On March 13, 2020, this Court issued Special Order No. 726928 regarding limitations of the Civil Presiding and Monitoring Court Dockets. On March 19, 2020, the Supreme Court of Texas (Misc. Order 20-944) and the Court of Criminal Appeals (No. 20-008) issued the Third Emergency Order Regarding COVID-19 State of Disaster, "prohibiting no-essential proceedings in person contrary to local, state and national directives." On March 23, 2020, County Judge Nelson Wolff and Mayor Ron Nirenberg issued a Stay at Home, Work Safe Order. In order to comply with those directives and in the interest of safety and welfare of the public, attorneys, clients and courthouse staff, the Bexar County Civil District Courts have now extended the limitations set out in the prior Order through April 3, 2020.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the March 13, 2020 Special Order No. 726928, is extended through April 3, 2020.
