

**SUPPLEMENTAL STANDING ORDER REGARDING OPERATIONS OF COUNTY
COURTS AT LAW HANDLING CIVIL MATTERS DURING COVID-19 PANDEMIC**

In the interests of protecting public safety, and consistent with the First Emergency and Third Order(s) Regarding the COVID-19 State of Disaster issued by the Supreme Court of Texas, (Misc. Docket No. 20-9042 and Misc. Docket No. 20-9044), the Judges of the Courts of the Bexar County Courts at Law have agreed to the following order:

1. Pursuant to Texas Supreme Court Docket No. 12-9208 and in the interest of protecting public safety and necessary social distancing protocols, all motions filed by Attorneys **must** be electronically filed. No filings by attorneys will be accepted via facsimile or hand delivery. Bond companies are also encouraged to e-file.
2. County Court at Law number 3 is the presiding Civil Court for the months of April and May. Settings for remote hearings may be requested to Court Coordinator, Norma Cavazos via email at ncavazos@bexar.org or by telephone at (210)335-2575. The Court will remotely conduct the hearings that have been deemed to be essential on Thursdays and Fridays.
3. For the health and safety of all parties involved and in accordance with Texas Supreme Court Docket No. 20-9042 and 20-9044, the Judges of the Bexar County Courts at Law prefer to remotely conduct any necessary hearings.
4. This order will remain in effect until May 8, 2020 pursuant to the above-referenced Texas Supreme Court Order(s) or until further order of the Court.
