PROCEEDINGS IN AUXILIARY JAIL COURT

In the interest of protecting the safety of all parties during this COVID-19 pandemic, effective April 28, 2020, the Auxiliary Jail court will remain operational; however, all jail court and inmate pleas will be conducted remotely via zoom videoconferencing.

All attorneys will continue to be provided a 48 hour notice of their inmate hearing and must respond to the Court Coordinator no later than 24 hours prior to the hearing to confirm their appearance at the hearing via Zoom. In the event that a court appointed attorney fails to respond or indicates they will not be able to attend via Zoom, the appointed attorney will be replaced by other appointed counsel. If the attorney is retained, the inmate's hearing will be canceled and/or reset until the attorney is available via Zoom.

This Order will remain in effect until June 1, 2020, or until further order of the County Court Judges.

It is ORDERED that this Order be filed for record with the County Clerk of Bexar County.
