

SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER REGARDING TEMPORARY SUSPENSION OF JURY SERVICE DUE TO PANDEMIC

On April 17, 2020, the Office of Court Administration issued Updated COVID-19 Guidance #7, recommending that all in-person proceedings of any size be delayed until at least June 1, 2020. The recommendation is based on the Supreme Court of Texas (No. 20-9044) and The Court of Criminal Appeals (No. 20-008) Third Emergency Order Regarding the COVID-19 State of Disaster, "prohibiting non-essential proceedings in person contrary to local, state, or national directives...". Given that the COVID-19 Pandemic continues to threaten the health and safety of the citizens of Bexar County and that the orders of the Local, State and Federal government regarding social distancing remain in effect, the Court hereby orders the extension of the temporary suspension of jury service through May 29, 2020. The Court will continue to evaluate the situation and make additional orders as needed.
