

AMENDED ORDER REGARDING CONDUCT OF BUSINESS IN COUNTY COURT AT LAW NUMBER 11
UNTIL FURTHER NOTICE

On March 22, 2020 Standing Order 2020 SO 03 was entered in an effort to provide access to the Court and timely resolution of matters presently pending, in accordance with the Emergency Orders of the Texas Supreme Court and Court of Criminal Appeals. Effective immediately the Court extends and amends 2020 SO 03 as follows:

1. Until further notice, all hearings will continue to be conducted via Zoom.
2. As recommended by the Office of Court Administration, all Court matters subject to the Open Courts Requirement will be broadcast via the Bexar County Court at Law No. 11 YouTube Channel.
3. To request a continuance, a Certificate of Conference and Request for Reset form (see attached) or Motion for Continuance must be submitted prior to the docket for the Court's consideration.
4. The Certificate of Conference form (signed by both parties) should be sent to the Court Coordinator via email to acastano2@bexar.org.
5. Attorney attendance to the Zoom Docket is required unless a reset was received from the Court.
6. Attorneys and Defendants are NOT ordered to appear in person unless expressly notified otherwise by the Court. Defendants are not required to attend unless counsel is specifically notified in advance. Defendants are entitled to appear in the Zoom Docket, not expressly notified to attend via Zoom. may attend if they desire and should be notified of this option by their Counsel.
7. If the Parties have reached a Plea Bargain Agreement, the parties should contact the Court Coordinator for a plea setting.
8. Plea paperwork may be done via Adobe Sign and is available upon request to the Court, prior to the day of the plea setting.

10. This order is subject to change or update at any time, if changed or updated, a notice will be filed with the County Clerk and published by the Court.
