



**SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER RELATING TO CRIMINAL DISTRICT COURT
OPERATIONS DURING COVID-19 PANDEMIC**

On April 17, 2020, the Office of Court Administration issued Updated COVID-19 Guidance #7, recommending that all in-person proceedings of any size be delayed until at least June 1st. The recommendation is based on the Supreme Court of Texas (No. 20-9044) and The Court of Criminal Appeals (No. 20-008) Third Emergency Order Regarding the COVID-19 State of Disaster, "prohibiting non-essential proceedings in person contrary to local, state, or national directives..."

The Courts of Bexar County will begin a slow process of re-opening beginning June 15, 2020, allowing limited non-essential in person hearings at the courts' discretion. The Court finds it necessary to extend the current weekly presiding court schedule through July with the following changes effective June 15, 2020:

- Each criminal district court will handle its own cases (cases from other courts will no longer be referred to the weekly criminal presiding court).
- The presiding criminal district court will handle warrants.
- The presiding criminal district court will handle matters for the 144th district court.
- The presiding criminal district court will handle any other matters that require immediate attention and that cannot be handled by the originating court remotely.

All parties shall contact the court for information on how the court will be conducting its docket.




