







ADULT PSYCHIATRIC EMERGENCY SERVICE TRANSFERS

Rolling 3 Month Transfers by System





STCC Project Updates

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- Program for Intensive Care Coordination (PICC):
 - Full year of implementation
 - 89 individuals enrolled
 - Enhanced on call response
 - Chronic Crisis Stabilization Initiative (CCSI):
 - 58 individuals enrolled
 - Crosspoint Behavioral Health Transitions for Men:
 - 22 individuals enrolled
 - Capacity up to 35
 - Acute Care Station (ACS):
 - COVID-19 response impact
 - MIH responding to statewide testing needs in March
 - Resumed June 15, 2020

New Projects in 2020

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- The PES System of Care has added 4 additional child and adolescent Psychiatric Emergency Service beds at Clarity Child Guidance Center as of April 6, 2020.
 - CHCS has expanded hospital liaison capabilities to support the Child PES at Clarity
 - Crosspoint has expanded capacity to add 10 transitional housing beds for women as of July 1, 2020
 - A Behavioral Health Rapid Access Clinic model has been developed to be able to provide pre crisis intervention for individuals in need of access to a timely psychiatric assessment and connection to outpatient care. The UT Health-Transitional Care Clinic has been identified as the provider and the anticipated launch date is September 2020.
