BE INCLUDED IN ALL FIATS OR NOTICES OF SETTINGS

Effective immediately, and until further notice, all Fiats or Notices of Hearings must contain all necessary information designated in the attached document, a copy of which is posted on the Bexar County Courts website at <https://www.bexar.org/1055/County-Courts>, and the Bexar County Clerk website at <https://www.bexar.org/2946/County-Clerk>, and shall be posted in the Bexar County Clerk's Civil Central filing office.

If you have a current setting for October through December, 2020, on the Civil County Court Presiding Court dockets, and have not already done so, you must amend your fiat or notice of setting to include all required information and file that amendment immediately. Failure to provide the required information at least by 12:00 p.m. the day before your hearing is set may result in your case not being assigned.
