**NOTICE OF BOND ELECTION
TO BE HELD BY
THE CITY OF ALAMO HEIGHTS, TEXAS**

TIME AND PURPOSE OF ELECTION. The City of Alamo Heights, Texas (the "*City*") will hold an election between the hours of **7:00 A.M. and 7:00 P.M.** on **Tuesday, November 3, 2020** ("*Election Day*"), in the City for the purpose of authorizing the issuance of general obligation bonds as further described below.

ELECTION DAY VOTE CENTERS. The Bexar County Elections Administrator is conducting the election for the City. Electors may cast their ballot on Election Day at any Vote Center located within Bexar County. Electors also may cast their early votes by mail by applying for an early voting ballot by mail through the Bexar County Elections Department (203 W. Nueva, San Antonio, Texas 78207). The last day to apply for early voting ballots by mail (received, not postmarked) is Friday, October 23, 2020.

OFFICIAL PROPOSITION. At said election the following PROPOSITION shall be submitted in accordance with law:

CITY OF ALAMO HEIGHTS PROPOSITION A

"Shall the City Council of the City of Alamo Heights, Texas be authorized to issue bonds of the City, in one or more series, in the aggregate principal amount of \$13,250,000 for the purpose of financing the City's portion of costs relating to the Austin Highway/Lower Broadway Improvement Project (which is a multi-modal street, sidewalk and drainage project being jointly funded by the Alamo Area Metropolitan Planning Organization, the Texas Department of Transportation, the San Antonio River Authority, the City, and possibly Bexar County), including constructing drainage improvements and repairing, restoring, relocating, improving, replacing, acquiring and constructing other utility facilities and surface level improvements (such as sidewalk widening, bike lanes, street lighting and landscape improvements) located along the Austin Highway/Lower Broadway Improvement Project, with said bonds to mature not more than 25 years from their date of issuance, bear interest at such rate or rates as approved by the City Council

(provided that such rate of interest shall not exceed the maximum rate per annum authorized by law at the time of the issuance of any issue or series of the bonds), and be issued and sold in accordance with law at the time of issuance, all within the discretion of the City Council; and shall the City Council be authorized to levy and cause to be assessed and collected ad valorem taxes on all taxable property in the City in an amount sufficient, within the limit provided by law, to pay the principal of and interest on said bonds?"

FORM OF BALLOT. The official ballots for said election shall be prepared in accordance with the Texas Election Code so as to permit the electors to vote "FOR" or "AGAINST" the aforesaid PROPOSITION, with the ballots to contain such provisions, markings, and language as required by law, and with such PROPOSITION to be expressed substantially as follows:

CITY OF ALAMO HEIGHTS PROPOSITION A

- FOR THE ISSUANCE OF \$13,250,000 OF BONDS FOR THE PURPOSE OF FINANCING THE CITY'S PORTION OF COSTS RELATING TO THE AUSTIN HIGHWAY/LOWER BROADWAY IMPROVEMENT PROJECT, INCLUDING CONSTRUCTING DRAINAGE IMPROVEMENTS AND REPAIRING, RESTORING, RELOCATING, IMPROVING, REPLACING, ACQUIRING AND CONSTRUCTING OTHER UTILITY FACILITIES AND SURFACE LEVEL IMPROVEMENTS (SUCH AS SIDEWALK WIDENING, BIKE LANES, STREET LIGHTING AND LANDSCAPE IMPROVEMENTS) LOCATED ALONG THE AUSTIN HIGHWAY/LOWER BROADWAY IMPROVEMENT PROJECT, AND LEVYING A TAX SUFFICIENT TO PAY THE PRINCIPAL AND
- AGAINST INTEREST THEREON

ELECTORS. All resident, qualified electors of the City shall be entitled to vote at said election.
