### NOTICE REGARDING CIVIL JURY TRIALS

In accordance with the Order of the Bexar County Local Administrative Judge Suspending Jury Service until March 14, 2022, issued by the Honorable Rosie Alvarado on February 11, 2022, all in-person jury trials are suspended until March 14, 2022.

For cases set for a civil jury trial during this period, the Bexar County Civil District Courts will accommodate remote jury proceedings upon agreement of all parties and bench trials upon agreement of all parties to waive a jury trial.

If your case is set for civil jury trial during this period and all parties are willing to proceed with a remote jury trial, please contact Lisa Dossmann, Chief Trial Assignment Clerk, at **210-335-2520** or via email at [monitoringcourt@bexar.org](mailto:monitoringcourt@bexar.org) at least 10 business days before your scheduled trial date to notify her. For all other cases set, you must appear at the Monitoring Court docket call on your scheduled trial date to secure a new trial date from the Court. The docket will be called via videoconference in the Monitoring Court's Zoom meeting room. The link to the Zoom meeting room is:
