Referral Quick Reference Guide

FVTC Referral packets must include the following:

Signed Referral from the originating court

Veterans full name, cause # and Bexar SID #

A good contact phone # and email for the veteran

A good contact phone # and email for the defense attorney

****If the veteran is on probation the name and phone # of the veterans PO**

Veterans

Must be a veteran of the United States Military or National Guard

*****Active Duty Personnel are assessed on a case by case basis*****

Must be on Bond *****we cannot assess a veteran who is in jail*****

Must be able to provide a valid DD214

Must be living in Bexar County or surrounding counties

Must be able to report to Bexar County in person for court/FVTC Program requirements

Must be willing to attend a VA mental health assessment

Veterans

Must have an eligible felony offense either already granted or pending disposition

Non-eligible cases (current and past) include Sex offense related charges to include but not limited to: Chapter 62, improper photography and pornography related charges

Cases to be reviewed on a case by case basis include but are not limited to:

42a.054 (3g) cases, Intoxication Assault, Fraud, Injury to Child/Elderly, Burglary-Force

FVTC Evaluations may take 4-6 weeks to be completed so resets for court dates need to be set accordingly.
