**ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER ON PROBATE COURT ONE ASSOCIATE JUDGE’S ORDERS**


All orders signed pursuant Texas Government Code section 54A.209(16) are considered Final as provided by section 54A.214(a) or (b) as applicable.

It is further ordered that pursuant section 54A.209 16(e) the Associate Judge may render and sign an order specifying that the court clerk shall issue letters testamentary or of administration; or letters of guardianship; or orders as applicable pursuant to the Texas Health & Safety Code.

The court further orders pursuant to 54A.212 that the Associate Judge shall file an Associate Judge’s report listing all orders signed. The Associate Judge’s report shall, IF accepted and signed by the referring court, constitute a part of the original orders noted therein.

It is further ordered that the Associate Judge’s report shall be maintained by the County Clerk and the referring court. The Associate Judge’s report may be maintained separately and shall be forwarded as a part of the clerk’s record in the event of appeal.
