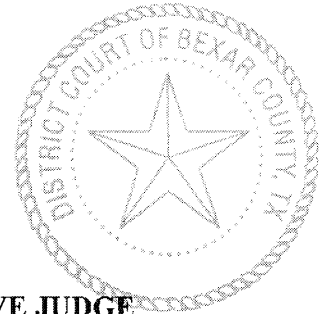

**ADVISORY OF THE BEXAR COUNTY LOCAL ADMINISTRATIVE JUDGE  
REGARDING THE WEARING OF FACE COVERINGS**

For purposes of this advisory the City of San Antonio Risk Level Dashboard and Progress and Warnings Indicators which can be found at: <https://covid19.sanantonio.gov/Reports-Statistics/Dashboards-Data>, shall be used to determine the transmission risk level. Further, the term "Courthouse Complex" shall include the Bexar County Courthouse, the Cadena Reeves Justice Center, the Paul Elizondo Tower, the Frank M. Tejeda Jr. Juvenile Justice Center, and all Justice of the Peace buildings for individuals coming to the buildings for court business.

Each judge has broad inherent authority to control orderly proceedings in their courtrooms, and may require individuals in the courtroom to wear facial coverings and social distance if necessary to maintain order and safety.

The COVID-19 positivity rate has increased to "high" risk level for transmission in the City of San Antonio and Bexar County. Aside from vaccinations, the Center for Disease Control and our local health authority advise that wearing face coverings is the single most effective way to reduce the spread of the COVID-19 virus. **Therefore, it is strongly advised that during periods of "high" risk level for transmission persons entering and remaining within the Courthouse Complex on court business use face coverings and social distance where possible.** It is strongly advised that procedures be implemented to minimize crowds and limit participants

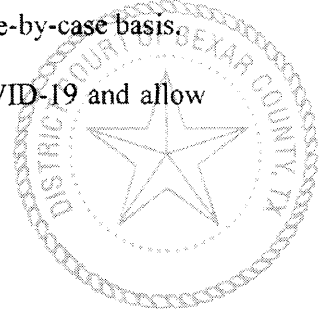
to those essential to the nature of the proceeding. Each individual court judge should implement this advisory to the best of their ability and consider each circumstance on a case-by-case basis.
