UPDATED SPECIAL ORDER REGARDING IN-PERSON PROCEEDINGS

To help alleviate any confusion or questions, the Judges of the Bexar County Courts at Law have prepared a general policy for each court as to how proceedings are being conducted at the present time. These general policies are subject to change at the discretion of the court with permission on a case-by-case basis. All jury trials will be held in person.

Courts hearing only Civil Matters (County Courts at Law Numbers 3 and 10): Motions and non-jury matters will be conducted via zoom, subject to ordering in-person hearings or non-jury trials on a case-by-case basis.

County Court at Law Number 1:

- Mondays: DWI Court/ Zoom plea docket
- Tuesdays through Thursdays: In-person dockets
- Fridays: Zoom dockets for pleas, motions, etc.
Defendants must appear for dockets.

County Court at Law Number 5:

- All court matters are being conducted in person

County Court at Law Number 6:

- The general policy below is effective until June 5, 2022
- Court will resume in-person operations on June 6, 2022

County Court at Law Number 2, 4, 6, 7, 8, 9, 11, 12, 13, 14, and 15:

- Attorneys may appear via zoom and are presumed to consent to zoom by their appearance.
- Defendants are ordered to appear unless otherwise excused in writing.

This Order is subject to change based on the metrics of the COVID-19 virus transmission rate as provided by the local health authority and the guidance from the Texas Office of Court Administration and Texas Supreme Court.
