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**Final Environmental Assessment and Finding of No Significant Impact  
Available for Public Review**

**Bulverde Road**

**From Marshall Road to Wilderness Oak**

Pursuant to Texas Administrative Code, Title 43, §2.108, this notice advises the public that a final environmental assessment (EA) is available for public review and the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) has issued a finding of no significant impact (FONSI) for the proposed Bulverde Road project from Marshall Road to Wilderness Oak in Bexar County, Texas. The environmental review, consultation, and other actions required by applicable Federal environmental laws for this project are being, or have been, carried-out by TxDOT pursuant to 23 U.S.C. 327 and a Memorandum of Understanding dated December 16, 2014, and executed by FHWA and TxDOT.

The proposed Bulverde Road project would widen Bulverde Road from a two-lane to a four-lane roadway. Construction will begin at TPC Parkway and extend 1.2 miles north of Marshall Road for a total construction length of 1.3 miles. A total of 2.83 acres of land would be required.

To avoid noise impacts that may result from future development adjacent to a proposed highway project, a traffic noise analysis is included in the final EA, which includes predicted noise impact contours for currently undeveloped areas. These impact contours are intended as a general guide to assist local planning officials and developers plan and construct new activities in locations that would not result in traffic noise impacts. On the date of approval/clearance of an EA/FONSI (including the traffic noise analysis) for a proposed highway project, TxDOT is no longer responsible for providing noise abatement for new development.
